Eight month wait in Employment Tribunal

Employers are waiting an average of eight months for employment tribunal claims to reach a hearing, according to research from <u>GQ|Littler</u>.

Data anlysis shows that the number of claims rose 27% last year, with the average waiting time of 237 days before cases are heard.

GOILittler found that the number of single claims received in 2018/9 was 35,430, up 27% on the previous year (27,920).

GO|Littler reports that in some tribunal courts, such as the Croydon Employment Tribunal, cases are now being listed for 2021.
